
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
## Built Heritage and Architectural Policy objectives



(i) provide a policy and legislative framework to protect architectural heritage as a national resource;


- (ii) promote increased public awareness and appreciation of architecture and our national built heritage;
- (iii) ensure that our built heritage is conserved, managed and planned for effective, sustainable management of our heritage resources.


















